Isn't that the type of environment we want to create for our children? Being organized both internally and on the surface is the key to creating that environment.

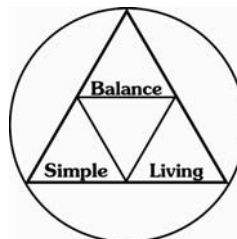

HOME ORGANIZER BINDER

The Home Administration Organizer Binder consists of 10 sections that are designed to hold all of the paper that typically clutters up refrigerators and kitchen counters (such as schedules, menus and coupons). The binder features checklists designed to help all members of the family stay on track with daily and weekly routines. There are pockets for things that often get lost such as passwords and library cards. Many of the sheets are laminated and it comes with a dry erase pen so schedules can be checked during the week and be wiped off for a new week.
